FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



What is Pinerock Camp and Retreat Center?

We are a retreat and conference facility designed to provide a unique place of ministry in the cool pines where churches and Christian organizations subscribing to our Statement of Faith can reach the lost for Christ and pursue spiritual growth through the study of God's word. We also reach out to schools looking for a unique place in nature for outdoor education.

What is Pinerock's Statement of Faith?

The purpose of Camp Pinerock, as a ministry of the Arizona/Southern Nevada District Church of the Nazarene, is to provide an opportunity for a life-changing experience with Jesus Christ to every person that comes on the grounds. Our objective is to provide excellent facilities in a relaxed mountain setting with a focus on:

1) spiritual enrichment 2) program support and educational training 3) moral and social development 4) recreation

What is the group size needed to make a reservation?

We book groups with a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 385. Groups less than 40 are welcome, but must come when another group is staying at the campground.

What is the difference between dorm-style and deluxe-style accommodations?

Dorm-style lodging is a room with one to four sets of twin and queen bunkbeds. There are no linens or towels provided so guests bring their own sleeping bags, pillows, and towels for showering. Bathrooms and showers are shared between rooms.

Basic cabins are like dorms in that there are no linens or towels provided, so guests bring their own sleeping bags, pillows, and towels for showering. However, basic cabins are free-standing buildings with bunks in several rooms throughout the entire cabin as well as private bathrooms.

Deluxe-style lodging is a cabin or hotel style accommodation with larger beds, linens and towels provided. There are kitchens/kitchenettes, living areas and private bathrooms in each cabin. This lodging is an additional \$15 per night per person during a group stay.

Floor plans of all accommodations are available on website.

How do we determine prices?

We charge per person and prices are determined by two factors:

- Style of accommodation(s)
- Number of nights/meals
- Family Retreat Only - Children attending a family camp with parents receive 25% discount (ages 4-10). Children ages 0-3 are free with a paid parent.

What is included in a retreat at Pinerock?

A well-maintained facility, delicious food, a meeting room, along with many fun activities at no extra charge!



FIVE STEPS TO THE IDEAL RETREAT



1). Call to check availability: 1(928) 445-8357 - You will need to know:

- ✓ Approximate number of guests in your group
- ✓ Dates interested (either specific or general time of year, mid-week vs. weekend)
- ✓ Preferred style of accommodation (dorms, cabins, or both)
- ✓ Number of nights you would like to stay
- ✓ Number of meals you will be eating with us

2). Make a reservation

As soon as you are ready to reserve available space, we will obtain all the necessary information such as:

- ✓ Group name
- ✓ Mailing address
- ✓ Best contact information

3). Complete contract and send deposit

- ✓ A contract will be sent to group leadership
- ✓ Initial and sign the signature page and send back within three weeks of receiving it
- ✓ Submit the deposit, which is 10% of the guaranteed minimum, calculated from the lowest possible price for the expected number of people

4). Let us help you with the details

Four weeks before your scheduled retreat we will send you a "Detail Sheet" to establish:

- ✓ Meeting room set-up
- ✓ Reservation of ball field, courts, etc.
- ✓ Actual number of participants

5). Enjoy the retreat!

Our friendly staff will be glad to serve you during your stay with us! Final payment is not due until arrival.
Please plan to settle-up with us during your retreat or conference.

TEAM-BUILDING COURSE




Ages: 10+







