Frequently Asked Questions

What is Pinerock Camp and Retreat Center?

We are a retreat and conference facility designed to provide a unique place of ministry in the cool pines where churches and Christian organizations subscribing to our Statement of Faith can reach the lost for Christ and pursue spiritual growth through the study of God's word. We also host schools who are looking for a unique place in nature for outdoor education.

What is Pinerock's Statement of Faith?

The purpose of Camp Pinerock, as a ministry of the Arizona/Southern Nevada District Church of the Nazarene, is to provide an opportunity for a life-changing experience with Jesus Christ to every person that comes on the grounds. Our objective is to provide excellent facilities in a relaxed mountain setting with a focus on:

- 1) spiritual enrichment
- 2) program support and educational training
- 3) moral and social development
- 4) recreation

What is the group size needed to make a reservation?

We book groups with a minimum of 40 (to open the dining hall) and a maximum of 375 guests. Groups less than 40 are welcome, they just have to be with a larger group to open the dining hall.

Are pets allowed at Pinerock

Due to allergy reasons pets of any kind are not allowed at Pinerock. Only certified service dogs are permitted.

Is there a smoking section?

All buildings are non-smoking/vaping, a deep cleaning fee of \$400 will be charged to the group plus any costs associated with blocking out the room for smoke removal. All outdoor areas are also non-smoking; we ask that guests leave campus to smoke or smoke in their vehicle with their windows up.

Is there a noise ordinance?

Pinerock does fall within the City of Prescott limits and must follow the city's noise ordinance. There is to be no outside amplification of any kind such as, stereos, megaphones, etc. during the groups time at Pinerock. After 9pm any inside amplified noise must be kept to a minimum and must only be heard within the groups meeting space.

Does Pinerock provide programs for groups?

Pinerock is a facilitator camp and not a program camp. Meaning that Pinerock provides groups with the needed facilities (lodging, meeting spaces, etc.) and groups run their own programs.

Steps to Reserve a Retreat

1). Call to check availability: 928-445-8357 - You will need to know:

- ✓ Approximate number of guests in your group
- ✓ Dates interested (either specific or general time of year, mid-week vs. weekend)
- ✓ Number of nights you would like to stay
- ✓ Number of meals you will be eating with us
- ✓ Preferred style of accommodation (dorms, cabins, or both)

2). Make a reservation

As soon as you are ready to reserve available space, we will obtain all the necessary information such as:

- ✓ Group name
- ✓ Mailing address
- ✓ Best contact information

3). Complete contract and send deposit

- ✓ A contract will be sent to group leadership
- ✓ Initial and sign the signature page and send back within three weeks of receiving it
- ✓ Submit the deposit, which is 10% of the contracted number of guest times the dorm room rate

4). Let us help you with the details

Four to six weeks before your scheduled retreat we will send you a “Detail Sheet” to establish:

- ✓ Meeting room set-up
- ✓ Reservation of ball field, courts, etc.
- ✓ Actual number of participants

5). Enjoy the retreat!

Our friendly staff will be glad to serve you during your stay with us! Final payment is not due until arrival; please plan to settle-up with us during your retreat.

Facilities- Lodging

Pinerock offers three different styles of lodging. Those are:

Dorm Rooms- These are rooms with one to four sets of twin bunk beds and restrooms are shared between rooms. Guests are responsible for bringing their own linens and towels.

Basic Cabins- Are free standing cabins that have several bunk beds throughout the cabin and inside restrooms. Guests are responsible for bringing their own linens and towels. They offer A.C. in the Summer.

Deluxe Cabins- Are cabins where linens and towels are provided. They also offer private restrooms, a kitchenette and A.C. in the Summer. These cabins are for leaders **only** during youth camps.

Pinerock Camp & Retreat Center is open year-round. However, the camp is closed Easter, Mother's Day and Thanksgiving weekends, and then closed for about two weeks for Christmas and New Years.

**The Number of Beds column does include pull out couches in the Deluxe Cabins.

Facilities- Meeting Spaces

Pinerock offers several different options for meeting spaces for any group size. They range from intimate boardroom style spaces to large assembly halls that can be set-up for worship services or sizeable gatherings. Audio and visual equipment, such as microphones, can be set up in most of our meeting spaces.

**Please note that Pinerock only offers wired handheld microphones. If the group wishes for wireless microphones they are to provide their own. Groups are also responsible for bringing their own sound A/V person. Pinerock staff can assist with initial meeting room setup and equipment turn on.

Groups may request meeting spaces, but Pinerock will assign meeting spaces. Meeting spaces are assigned based on group size and number of groups on any given date. They are also subject to change based on actual number of participants.

Rates

Pinerock's rates are per person based. All rates include lodging, meals, meeting space, use of ball field, use of basketball/volleyball courts and one campfire. Rates are based on number of nights and number of meals. Dorm Rooms, Basic Cabins and Deluxe Cabins all have separate rates. Groups will usually have a mixture of every type of lodging on their contract. **For family groups only:** children ages 4-12 receive a 25% discount off the given adult rate of each type of lodging. Recreation: Pinerock's recreation facilities will be shared by all users on the grounds. Reservations can be arranged with Pinerock staff on a first come, first served basis. The courtyard area of camp is not considered a recreational area and should be respected as a common area for quiet fellowship. All sports/recreational activities should be directed to the lower grass field and surrounding areas. We also ask groups to provide their own recreation equipment (sports balls, cones, etc.).

Activities

Pinerock offers many types of facilitated and non-facilitated activities. Facilitated activities are ones where Pinerock staff **must** run the activity and are an extra charge. Non-facilitated activities are games on the ball field, basketball/volleyball courts and disc golf. We also have onsite hiking trails with other trails a short drive away. ALL ACTIVITIES (both facilitated and non-facilitated) MUST BE RESERVED BEFORE GROUPS ARRIVAL. IF GROUPS DO NOT RESERVE PRIOR TO THEIR EVENT, WE ARE UNABLE TO GUARANTEE FACILITATORS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR THE CHOSEN ACTIVITIES.

All facilitated activities require a minimum of 10 participants and must be at least two hours long. Offered activities are:

Swimming Pool- Pool capacity is 50 people and can be reserved from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Groups can choose to either reserve the pool with one lifeguard (20 or less people) or two lifeguards.

Climbing Wall- Guests must be seven years or older and fit into our harnesses to participate on our climbing wall. **New climbing walls coming soon!**

Climbing Tower- Guests must be 12 years or older and fit into our harnesses to participant in High Ropes. **New Elements coming soon!**

Zip Line- Guests must be seven years or older and fit into our harnesses to use the zip line.

Paintball Markers- Guests must be 13 years or older to participate. Pinerock provides face coverings, CO2, markers and one hopper full of paintballs. If guests would like more paintballs, they are welcome to pay for extra.

Archery- Guests must be 10 years or older to participate. This is the only activity that we will do a one-hour minimum time slot.

Low Ropes (Team building) Course- Guests must be 10 years or older to participate in our Low Ropes Course. Participants must work together to conquer a variety of challenging activities that put your group to the test of team building.

Pinerock's offered non-facilitated activities are:

Disc Golf, also known as Frisbee Golf- It is a great activity to get you out and exploring while playing our nine-hole course. Starting in the rocks behind Lion's Dorm, the course will take you around our sports field, up and over hills, and through scenic pine forest.

Ball Field- Our ball field is the perfect area for sports, activities, and field games. There are bleachers and covered Ramada's with tables and chairs for spectators to sit and watch.

Basketball/Volleyball Courts- We also offer two basketball and one volleyball court for groups to use.

Hiking- Pinerock Camp & Retreat Center is situated on nearly 61 acres of beautiful terrain. Be sure to spend some time exploring our camp while hiking our beautiful trails throughout the property.
